Read the following at the beginning of both activities. We are going to do an activity which requires you to carefully listen to my directions. I will only say each direction once and it is your job to follow it. I will first tell you where to put the pencil on the paper I have given you.

Listening and Following Directions

The lines on the paper go in three directions which correspond to x, y and z axes. Try drawing a cube to see how it works. In math class, teachers might use isometric graph paper for activities related to spatial sense such as drawing rectangular prisms, connecting cube structures, composite 3D figures or the measurement of interiors.

Answer. Draw the x and y axes. Mark the units along the x and y axes with a suitable scale. (i) To plot the point A (7, 0) Here, the x-coordinate of A is 7 which is positive and the y-coordinate of A is zero. Hence the point A (7, 0) lies on the x-axis. Start at the Origin.

Now place the ruler on the left side of your paper, and make a small mark at every inch. Then place the ruler on the right side of the paper, and do the same thing. Then, using your ruler, make a straight line connecting the dots on the left with their partners on the right. Voila, you've got a grid!

I drew in the curve of the chin in box J4. Step 3. Follow the outline from box to box, using the grid labels to help you know where you are.

Follow these directions to create a graph using Excel. Open up Microsoft Excel. Put cursor in Cell A1, click and type in “Probability Graph” and your first and last name. Press “enter” when finished. Put the cursor in cell E1 and type the following: “Prediction of what outcomes will be.”

You will need a y-axis (up and down) and an x-axis (side to side). Typically, but not always, these will intersect in the lower left corner of your graphpaper. Graphs are always Y vs. X. For example a graph of mass vs. volume would have masson the y-axis and volume on the x-axis. Take a look at your data.
