The following deductions are allowed for SNAP: A 20-percent deduction from earned income. A standard deduction of \$167 for household sizes of 1 to 3 people and \$178 for a household size of 4 (higher for some larger households and for households in Alaska, Hawaii, and Guam).

Food Stamps Eligibility Your total household income must be below a certain number. That number is based on the total number of people in your household. To be eligible, the maximum gross monthly income is 130% of the federal poverty level.

Thus, 130 percent of the poverty line for a three-person family is \$2,353 a month, or about \$28,200 a year. The poverty level is higher for bigger families and lower for smaller families. [3] Net income, or household income after deductions are applied, must be at or below the poverty line.

### Income Eligibility Guidelines | USDA-FNS

The Georgia Food Stamps Income Limit for 2020 is based on your household's total income and size. To find out if your income meets the eligibility requirements you must first calculate the gross monthly income for your household. For instructions on how to calculate your gross monthly income, follow the steps below.

### Georgia Food Stamps Income Limit [2020-2021] - Georgia ...

Factors include household size, monthly income, and if a member of your household is 60-years-old or older, or has a disability. The best way to determine if and how much your household will qualify for SNAP is to apply. Income requirements, beginning Oct. 1, 2019 through Sept. 30, 2020:

### SNAP Income Limits - Department of Human Services

The gross income limit is equal to 185% of the current Federal Poverty Level and is the amount of income the household has before taxes and deductions. The gross income limit applies to most households. The gross income limit does not apply to households in which at least one person is 60 years of age or older, or receives disability income.

### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program - SNAP--Eligibility

Eligibility depends on several factors like income, household size, resources, etc. The chart below can help you figure out what is the maximum income allowed according to your household size. Gross Monthly Income Eligibility Standard (185% of FPL)
