### Dictionary of Aviation Terms and Abbreviations

aerostat: A lighter-than-air craft, such as a balloon or airship. Its lift is caused by buoyancy relative to the surrounding air. ailerons: On an aircraft, the ailerons are a control surface usually on the trailing edge of the wings. The ailerons are used to control roll by generating asymmetric wing lift.
