Understanding Shutter Speed for Beginners - Photography Basics

We can select a fast shutter speed that freezes any action in a photo, or we can select a slow shutter speed that introduces 'motion blur' to any moving objects within our image. Combining a panning motion of the camera (left to right, or right to left movement) with a slow shutter speed can be used to give a sense of speed, as in the car photo that opens this article.
