Sterilisation is essential to ensure that surgical instruments do not act as pathogen vectors. The most common method is autoclaving. In the autoclave the instruments must always be in the open position to allow the steam to reach all surfaces. Do not overload the autoclave trays, which would block the steam penetration.

These typically include towel clamps, a scalpel handle (and blade), a needle driver, thumb forceps, suture scissors, tissue cutting scissors and hemostatic forceps (usually some mosquito forceps, a few crile forceps and maybe some Carmalt forceps).
